Atria Cares<sup>SM</sup> is a nonprofit organization that provides emergency financial assistance – not loans – to qualifying employees who are faced with financial hardships due to unforeseen and often tragic events in their personal lives.

### Events that may qualify an employee for Atria Cares assistance:

- Experiencing loss due to a fire, flood or other natural disaster
- Involvement in a severe auto accident
- Suffering from a sudden, acute illness or injury
- Unsafe or unhealthy living conditions
- Experiencing an unexpected death in the family
- Falling victim to a crime

### Financial challenges that may be considered for assistance as a result of a qualifying event:

- Emergency food, shelter, clothing and other essential items in the aftermath of a natural disaster or other tragedy
- Past due essential utilities (water, gas, electric)
- Emergency medical and dental bills not covered by insurance
- Past due rent/mortgage
